

Rules of La Madrona's Singles Ladder Play:

- Any club member who can play a match may participate.
- All Club Championships participants and junior team players are placed on the ladder automatically.
- A new player must contact one of the tennis coaches in order to be given a range to challenge and then, upon completion of a match, will be placed on the ladder.
- Players may challenge up to 3 spaces above and the person challenged must either accept or forfeit.
- Challenger first calls opponent and negotiates a good time to play. Challenger brings a new can of balls and winner reports the score to the tennis office.
- Play two-out-of-three sets, regular scoring. A 10-point tie-breaker may be used in lieu of the 3rd set.
- The top 3 junior girls and junior boys may challenge on the adult ladders; the top woman player may challenge on the men's ladder.
- Year-end awards will be presented to the Most Improved, Most Challenges and King or Queen of the Ladder.
